If you happen to visit our campus here in Fox Chase, you may see a beautiful exhibition in our hallway, to honor a Sister who has passed on or to highlight a holiday or event. A large part of that work is completed by our Archivist, Lucy Hall. She puts in a lot of effort to create these exhibitions, while managing the archives for MMS, as well as other projects here in Fox Chase.

In August of this year, Lucy was awarded the inaugural Sister Rosalie McQuaide, CSJP (Congregation of the Sisters of St. Joseph of Peace)

Award. According to the Archivists for Congregations of Women Religious

website, "The Sister Rosalie McQuaide, CSJP Award recognizes the work of an archivist of women religious for a project that demonstrates innovation, clear organization, and well-planned implementation resulting in greater access." Lucy received the award based on her work assembling an on-line archive of "The Medical Missionary." "The Medical Missionary" was a magazine published by MMS from October 1, 1927, until October 1, 1970.
